An agricultural – dairy herdsperson maintains the health, nutrition, and breeding of milk cows, works with milk processing and sterilizing equipment, performs milking, feeding, watering, herd health procedures and herd maintenance and operates and maintains farm mechanical equipment and electrical systems.
