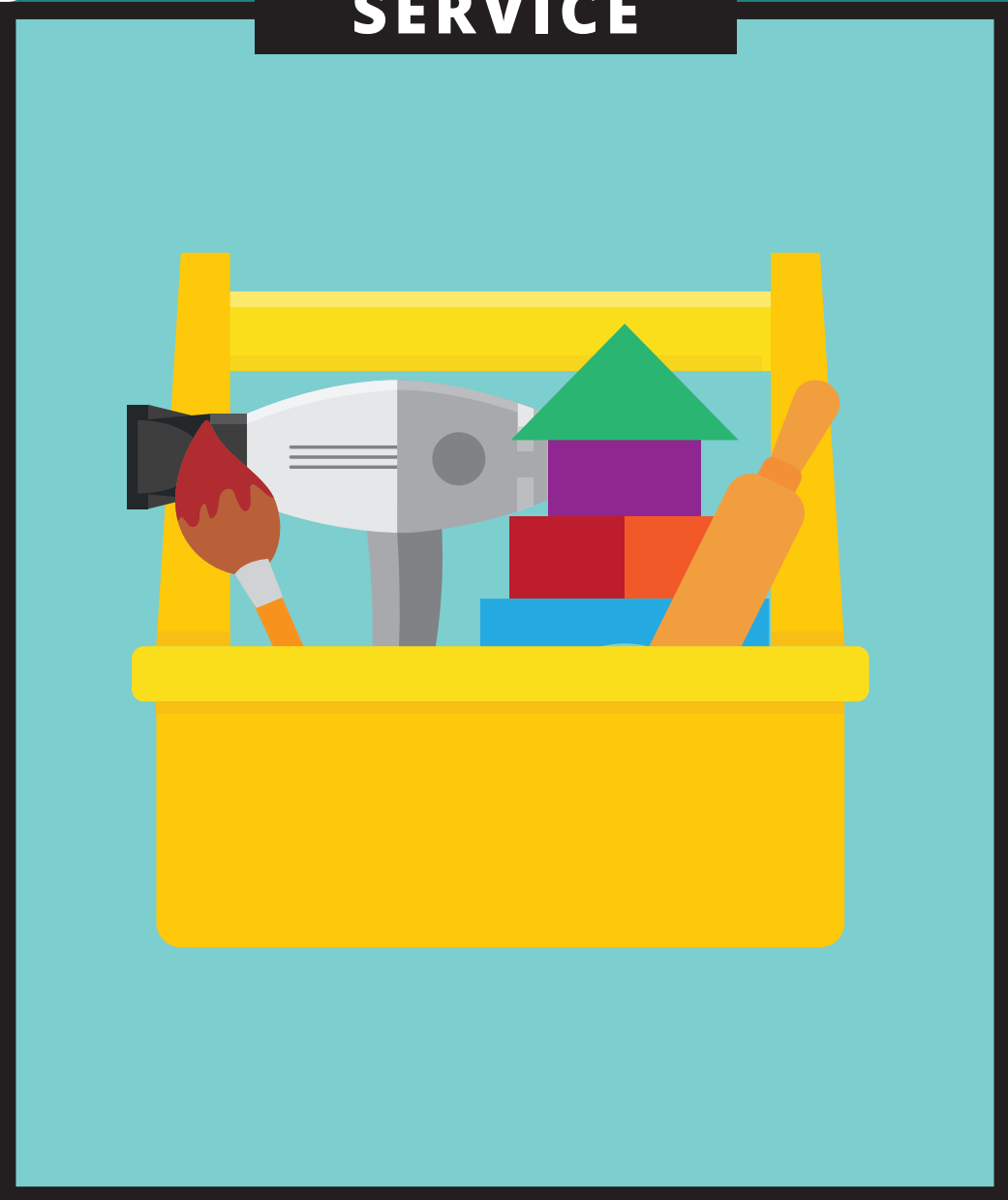

An appliance service technician installs, assembles, disassembles, removes, services, repairs, maintains and disposes of domestic appliances and electrical household products.
